The book of Leviticus, as a whole, is addressed to all the people of Israel (see 1:2["speak to all the people of Israel!"]; 4:2;7:22,28; 11:1-2; 12:1-2; 15:1-2, etc.). Leviticus was not a priestly handbook! Leviticus, as we have already seen, instructsIsrael how to live in the presence of a holy God.

Its Hebrew title, wayyiqra', is the first word in the Hebrew text of the book and means "And he [i.e., the Lord] called."
